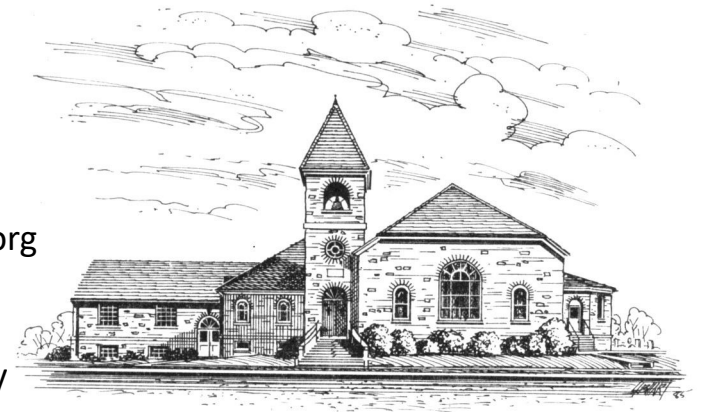

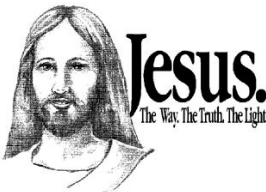
Adults & Youth: Call to Action!
