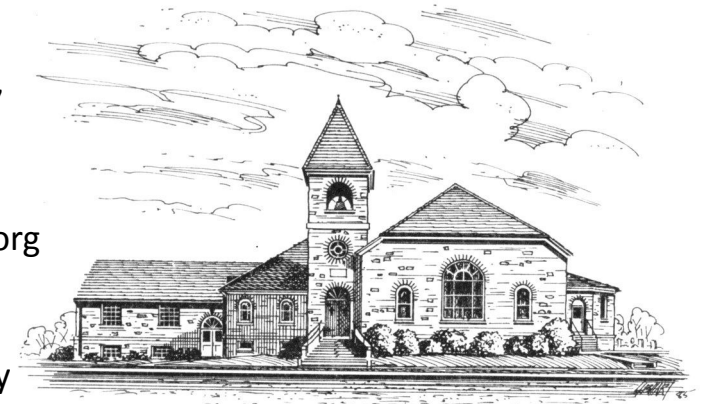

Why \$9 Shipping Cost?

The \$9 per shoebox gift is critical for Operation Christmas Child. It covers the cost of transporting the shoeboxes to eight different processing centers. At the eight processing center warehouses the shoeboxes are secured and prepared for international shipment. Millions of shoeboxes are transported by ships, trucks, and airplanes to the countries



where they will be distributed. Also, the fee helps to train and equip local churches to use a Ministry Partner Guide which shows churches how to share the Good News in a child-friendly way. Your donation also provides The Greatest Gift Gospel booklets which are written in the children's native language.
